Spring Gathering: Opportunities to Share!

As we gather at Belgrade UMC in North Mankato on April 22nd, we have many ways to share. First, our MN Annual Conference will be collecting UMCOR <u>Feminine Hygiene Kits</u> so we are asking you to bring items as we will be assembling kits to donate at Annual Conference. Items included in the kit are:

- 2 oz bottle of hand sanitizer
- Travel pack of wet ones
- Tampons: Regular & super absorbency—Unscented
- Sanitary Napkins: Long super ultra-thin—Unscented
- Bath-size soap (3 oz bar or larger)—No Ivory or Jergen's
- Flushable wipes (42 count)—Unscented
- Travel sink-size laundry detergent (.25-.45 oz)
- **We will provide the one-gallon re-sealable bag and 4-gallon bathroom trash bags

A second way to share is bringing items for **Emma Norton Services**. Items included on their winter donation needs list are:

A story from Midwest Mission Distribution Center (MMDC) near Springfield, MO:

A.God. Moment. Basic hygiene supplies were being collected for Turkey. The humanitarian aid contact stated that they needed sizes to be uniform and the different items be put in one bag to pass out to individuals. When MMDC heard about this, they said that's exactly what their Personal Dignity Kit is, and why the kits are always ready for when a disaster hits! Each kit contains shampoo, a toothbrush, toothpaste, a bar of soap, a hand towel, a washcloth, deodorant, and a razor. And they had a number of kits ready to be sent to Turkey! WOW! Your donations, volunteer hours, and prayer allowed MMDC to quickly respond to the request. Through destruction and chaos, we look for how God is working, and rely on the Spirit to guide us into action.
